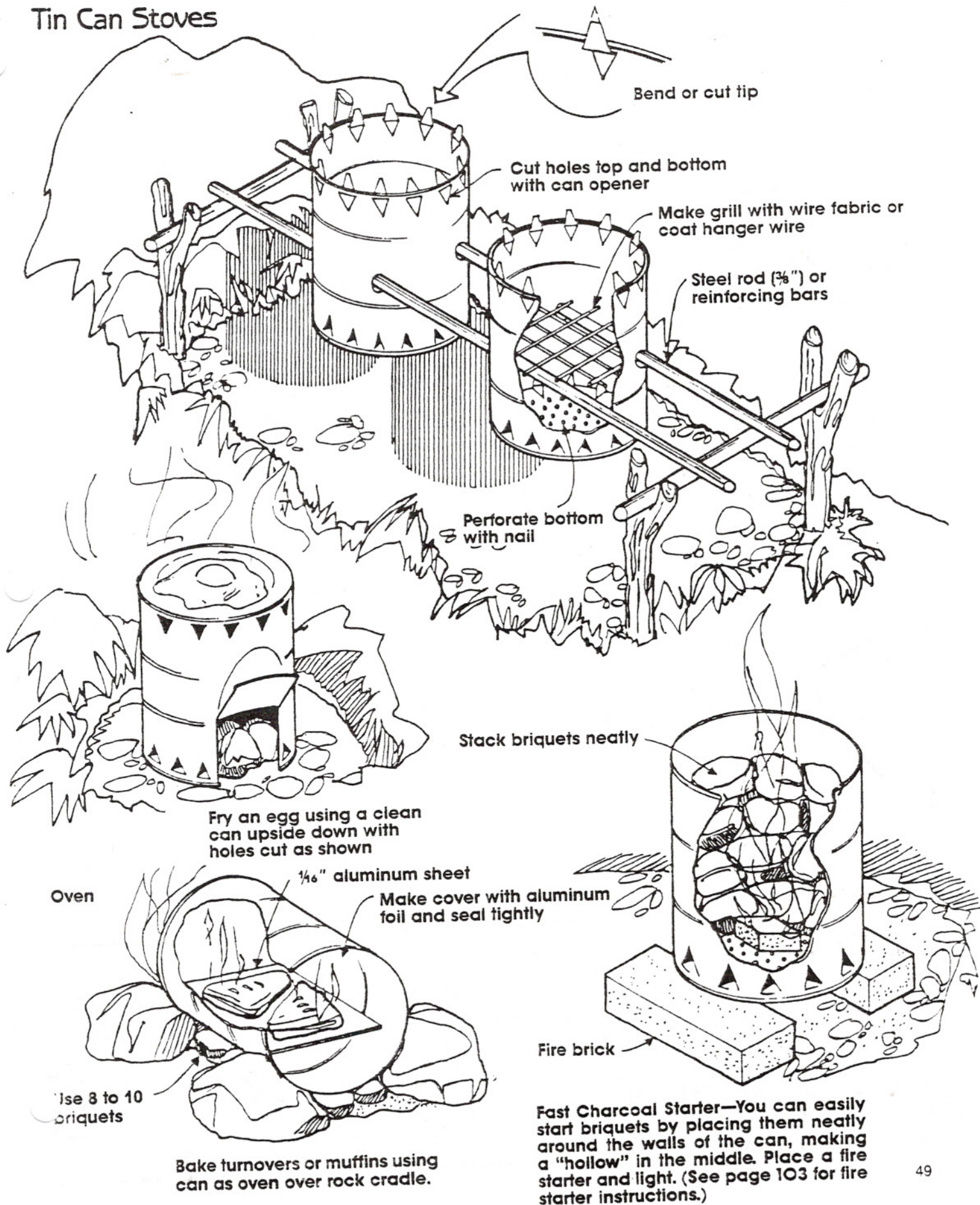


Tin Can Stoves



Bend or cut tip

Cut holes top and bottom with can opener

Make grill with wire fabric or coat hanger wire

Steel rod (3/8") or reinforcing bars

Perforate bottom with nail

Fry an egg using a clean can upside down with holes cut as shown

Stack briquets neatly

Oven

1/16" aluminum sheet

Make cover with aluminum foil and seal tightly

Use 8 to 10 briquets

Bake turnovers or muffins using can as oven over rock cradle.

Fire brick

Fast Charcoal Starter—You can easily start briquets by placing them neatly around the walls of the can, making a "hollow" in the middle. Place a fire starter and light. (See page 103 for fire starter instructions.)
